Guidelines for participation include:

- Sign-ups will begin during the week of December 14th during the Advisory period.
- Student teams may include 1 to 4 students.
- Limited equipment will be available for use and will be signed out through the front office.
- An advisor will be assigned to each team to help throughout the process.
- There is a two minute time limit on all films submitted.
- Films may not include any violent or inappropriate content.
- A screening committee will be comprised of school administration, teachers and parents. Each film will be pre-screened twice prior to the showcase night.
- The final decision of questionable content is left to the screening committee.
- The following dates are screening dates. Films must be submitted by these dates.
 - 1st Screening – January 26th
 - 2nd Screening – March 18th
